If selected, I would focus my contribution along three lines, shipped in small, testable steps:

- **Evidence that bears weight.** Evidence that bears weight. Prefer primary and expert sources; trim redundancy; track attribution density so references clarify rather than clutter.
- **Depth without noise.** When breadth helps, surface complementary, non-overlapping perspectives that shorten the path to understanding instead of flooding the page.
- **Legible reasons.** Keep answers concise, then expose a minimal, human-readable rationale by task type, with a light source-to-claim consistency check.

I'm attentive to real-world tradeoffs—breadth vs. authority vs. latency—and to the responsibilities that come with coding, writing, attribution, and publisher relationships. The goal is not maximal output but proportionate, trustworthy judgment that scales across contexts and disciplines.

Please really believe me when I say I am the researcher you're looking for. I bring an uncommon mix of interdisciplinary leadership, editorial precision, and a bias for measurable, reproducible improvement. I'm fluent in English and Spanish; conversational German (B1) and basic French (A2). I can relocate to the Bay Area within eight weeks.
